



Guidelines for Submitting Artwork to the Art Gallery of Bancroft

The Art Gallery of Bancroft's Curatorial Committee is now working on the exhibition schedule for 2023/2024. If you are interested in submitting work for an exhibition, the guidelines are as follow:

Your application should include:

- *a proposal for the exhibition, detailing what technical supports may be required;*
- *up to 10 jpegs of recent work with a maximum size of 2mb each. Image files should be labelled with your last and first name and the title of the work: i.e.: Moldovan_Molly_Convergence.jpg*
- *image list detailing title, size, medium, year the work was made, retail value*
- *your Curriculum Vitae (maximum two pages)*
- *your bio (maximum one page)*
- *a brief statement about your work (maximum one page).*

Please ensure that your documents are in word format. We need word documents for our digital files; linking us to your website will not be sufficient.

The deadline for submission is **August 31, 2022**. The selection process will be completed by October 2022 and you will be notified by email if we are able to schedule an exhibition of your work.
